Dear Sisters,

At the last general meeting of the International Women's Day Committee, a motion of support to the Fleck strikers was passed overwhelmingly. These strikers - the majority of whom are women have been struggling for two months against fierce repression by the Fleck management and police.

Our committee was approached by the United Auto Workers and Organized Working Women to help build picket line support and a public rally to help the Fleck workers win their battle. Within the framework of our previous decision, the Liaison committee agreed enthusiastically and this mailing is part of our efforts to help. We have promised to bring at least forty women to the May 19th picket line, knowing that it is difficult to go, but realizing the importance of women's support for the strike. We hope that you can build this support and add your strength and solidarity.
