

REPORT OF THE WOMEN'S COMMITTEE
TO THE EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING
DECEMBER 15, 1978

The committee has met three times since its last report and has made the following recommendations:

1. That registration forms for future Federation events include identification by sex.
2. That the Federation contribute up to \$100 to cover any deficit which may have arisen from the ONDP Women's Conference held November 17, 18, and 19, 1978.
3. That the Federation invite the ONDP Women's Committee to establish a liaison with our committee by appointing a representative to sit with voice but no vote.
4. That the Federation make an effort to attend conventions and other activities of affiliated organizations to make them aware of our women's program.
5. That representatives of the Women's Committee meet jointly with representatives of the Education Committee to consider the feasibility of the Federation developing the resources required by affiliated organizations wishing to offer a Family Education Program similar to that operated by the UAW.

The main work of the committee over the next few months will be organizing a women's conference. A complete proposal for this project will be ready for the January meeting of the Executive Council.
