NEWSLETTER: JULY 1977

LOOT is an umbrella organization for lesbians. It serves social, recreational, personal, cultural, political, and educational purposes for the women involved. Mostly, it simply allows a lesbian to meet and get together with other lesbians who share her interests.

All lesbians are welcome. To help make decisions about LOOT, you just have to come to meetings. We do not exclude anyone on the basis of her race, religion, politics, economic status, occupation, or degree of openness.

Relate to LOOT in any way you wish. The organization is new and can become whatever you want to make it. The LOOT general meeting is on the last Sunday of every month (except for August, see below) at 4:00. Drop-ins are held on Tuesday (with supper) and Friday evenings, when the phone-line is also open.

THE AUGUST GENERAL MEETING HAS BEEN CHANGED! Because a lot of women will be out of town on August 28th (at the Mt. Pleasant Music Festival), the August meeting will be held oneweek early on Sunday, August 21, at the usual time of 4 p.m. All other meetings will be held as usual, on the last Sunday of every month.

If the weather permits, LOOT will try again to host a picnic at Hanlin's Point on Sunday, July 17, starting at 1 p.m. Brings your own food, frisbees, softballs, etc.

Two American studies on female sexuality found that of two groups of women, 162 lesbians and 100 randomly selected women, only 18 % of the random sample almost always experienced orgasm during lovemaking as opposed to 87 % of the lesbians surveyed.

LOOT has become a member of the National Gay Rights Coaltion (NGRC) which is committed to achieving civil rights for gay people. Chris Bearchell is attending their national conference in Saskatoon (July 1-4) and will give us a full report in the next newsletter.

LOOT'S MONEY

As of the June 26 general meeting LOOT has a bank balance of about \$315. We received \$150 from the Women's Counseeling, Referral and Education Centre (WCREC) for the participation of LOOT members in a workshop on lesbians in therapy. Also, LOOT made \$77 on the last LotoLesbian drawing (an equal amount went to the lucky winner at the June 18 benefit dance). Women continue to buy supporter cards and t-shirts, and we have made about \$160 from these sales in the last two months. Thanks for your support!

Our major expense has been rent and utilities for the house, especially since LOOT and the 3 of Cups were the only house tenants in June. However, the June 18 benefit dance was quite successful in paying house bills, and LOOT will have to pay little if any rent in July. Our other ongoing expenses

are phone bills and mailing costs for the newsletter.

As you have probably noticed, the LOOT Newsletter is now being mailed with the 3 of Cups newsletter. This saves both organizations time and money, while also giving us wider circulation.

Ambitious Amazons are a collective of lesbians in Michigan who put out Lesbian Connection about eight times a year. Included are articles, news, reviews, announcements on lesbian happenings, ads, letters, and a listing of 'contact dykes' in towns across the continent. These women offer Lesbian Connection free to all lesbians, although they ask for an \$8 donation (more if you can, less if you can't), and require \$3 to cover excessive postage to Canada (also \$4 for extra postage and supplies if you want it sent in an envelope). It's a great source of lesbian news and thought, and can be read at the LOOT office or ordered by writing: Ambitious Amazons, P.O. Box 811, East Lansing, Michigan 48823, U.S.A.

After a neighbour told police that pornographic films were being shown at the gay men's centre in Boston, Mass, police raided the place. What they found, however, was a screening of the Judy Garland film, A Star is Born. Members of the centre offered to put the police on the mailing list announcing future films.

After a discussion at July's general meeting, LOOT endorsed the following statement and action:

More and more women are losing custody of their children, both in and outside the courts—to husbands, relatives, and the Children's Aid Society. When we are without money or a 'stable' relationship with a man, we are especially vunerable to the threat of losing our children—if we are lesbians, single mothers, immigrants, in prison, ill—mentally or physically, or prostitutes.

Wages Due Lesbians is organizing a picket in front of the Supreme Court of Ontario to protest these injustices and the forced invisibility of our

fight to have and keep the children we want.
