What it's all about

Breaking the Barriers Part 2 will be held the evening of Friday, May 27 and all day Saturday May 28, at the University of Toronto Medical Sciences Building. As you will remember, the 200 women who attended last year's conference concentrated on the upcoming provincial election and changes we could make as women in the NDP. Partly as a result of that conference 40 women ran provincially and for the first time we had a women's organizer during the election.

At Breaking the Barriers, on Friday night we will focus on the pending federal election. Saturday we will discuss provincial issues important to women and how we can highlight them at the party's June convention in Thunder Bay. We will also elect the Women's Committee Executive, and determine our priorities for the next year.

We are asking women across the province to get involved in this year's conference. Please pass our invitation to the women in your organization through newsletters, phone calls, and mailings.

Choosing delegates

Again this year, the conference will be made up of elected delegates of ridings, campus clubs, affiliated organizations, labour councils and ethnic advisory committees. Our goal is to have as geographically, culturally, and ethnically diverse a conference and committee as possible. Delegates should be women and members in good standing of the New Democratic Party.

Please consider now how your organization will select delegates. You could, for example, elect delegates for this conference when electing provincial convention delegates. Or you may wish to hold a separate general meeting or ask a general meeting to allow the executive to select delegates. When this process is complete, we'd appreciate receiving the attached registration form before Friday, May 6.

Delegate entitlements

- •Riding associations and campus clubs: One delegate for the first 50 women members or less, and one additional delegate for each additional 50 women members or major fraction of that number. In the absence of gender-coded lists from Provincial Office please determine your entitlement to the best of your ability. Delegates should be elected at a duly constituted general meeting.
- *Affiliated organizations are entitled to one woman delegate for the first 1,000 members, and one additional delegate for each additional 1,000 members or major fraction of that number.
- •Every labour council is entitled to one woman delegate. The Ontario Federation of Labour is entitled to two women delegates.
- Each Advisory Committee is entitled to one woman delegate.
- •All organizations are entitled to an equal number of alternates, but must fill their delegate complement before they can send alternates.
- ·Observers are welcome.
