WAGES FOR HOUSEWORK CAMPAIGN: an international group organizing for recognition of women's work in the home and seeking an immediate increase in welfare benefits for mothers and youth.

REGENT PARK TEEN ASSOCIATION: a group of teens getting together to help combat unemployment amongst the teens.

WAGES DUE LESBIANS: an international lesbian group in the Wages for Housework Campaign; have recently started a **LESBIAN MOTHERS' DEFENCE FUND** to help women fighting for child custody and to publicize the fight for custody rights for lesbian mothers.

WAITRESSES' ACTION COMMITTEE: a lobby group organizing to prevent a cut in the minimum wage for tip earners such as waitresses.

BEAVER (Better End All Vicious Erotic Repression): Canada's first organizational voice for prostitutes and other workers of the flesh; organizing for decriminalization of prostitution.

PAY DAY: a group of men actively supporting the struggles of women and youth for money of their own; "The more our 'dependents' win, the greater our power to demand more money and better lives."
