A. POLITICAL FUNCTION

Recent history of abortion movement in Toronto Deteriorating situation with respect to access to abortion Summer 1982 -- free-standing abortion clinic becomes a possibility Sept. 1983 -- OCAC formed as political body to build broad public support for legalizing FS clinics OCAC role in: 1) Mobilizing women's movement around abortion issue

- 1) MODILIZING WOMEN S MOVEMENT ATOLINA ADDITION .
- 2) Reaching out beyond our movement
- 3) Working to change law
