Abortion: for survival

Produced by the Fund for the Feminist Majority, Los Angeles, Calif., this 30 minute video focuses on health professionals who remind us of the time when abortion was illegal. Dr. Allan Rosenfield of Columbia University, for instance, recalls when more than 1/3 of the patients on an obstetrics-gynecology ward were victims of illegal abortion.

Major distributors of the film in the U.S. include the National Black Women's Health Project, the Religious Coalition for Abortion Rights and the Federation of Feminist Women's Health Centers. The Canadian Abortion Rights Action League is now distributing the video in Canada.
