Dear Prime Minister Chrétien

Women across Canada have been appalled by the government's refusal to act on the issue of violence against women. We have been demanding concrete action since December 6, 1989 when 14 young women were murdered in Montreal.

Last spring the Women's March drew the links between increasing poverty and violence in our society. The Women's March demanded action against poverty, action on job creation and for federal funding for services for women.

Your government should immediately commit the \$50 million dollars core funding. The National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women requires nothing less.
