A Trust meeting was held in Ottawa, December 5th, and the following projects were approved:

1. Slide-Tape Show on the status and struggles of Canadian Women for use with general audiences, to be produced by Sylvia Spring, Galiano Island, B.C.
2. Slide-Tape show on the lives of Canadian Indian Women and the implications of Section 12(1)(b), to be produced by Shirley Bear, Big Cove, N.B.
3. Assistance to print the proceedings of an Equal Pay Conference sponsored by the Working Women's Education Committee, Halifax.
4. Regional Pensions Conferences for Women in Toronto, Calgary, Winnipeg and Regina.
5. Assistance to print a bilingual Pensions Kit.

Since the Trust is new, we are still trying to develop it as an effective educational arm of NAC. The next meeting will be held at the time of the January NAC Executive Meeting and the main agenda item will be further discussion of the relationship of the Trust to the NAC Executive and member groups.

The Trust is continuing to approach foundations for support and we have received some encouraging responses. Suggestions are welcome.
