The NAC Annual General Meeting will take place from the evening of March 25 through the morning of March 28, 1983, in Ottawa.

Continuing inflation and now almost 230 member groups put a strain on NAC's limited funds for subsidizing travel, the largest single item in our AGM budget. We wish to assist delegates as much as we can, but estimate member organizations may be asked to pay at least \$50 and as much as \$200 of one delegate's travel costs by the cheapest transportion available. This means that delegates within a certain radius of Ottawa will receive no travel assistance.
