

Management of the fund

The monies collected will be held in trust in a designated savings account. There will be four trustees who will be responsible for the care of these monies. These trustees are Sandra Stienecker, Peter Tabuns, Jane Bertrand and Evelyn McKee. In the event of the resignation or death of any one of the trustees, the remaining three will appoint a new trustee. The Action Day Care office will continue to be the mailing address for the fund.

The monies collected in this fund will be kept in an interest-bearing state for a period up to five years. During this time any community group that has the Neighbourhood Resource Centre (hub model) as its goal and can satisfy the trustees of its commitment to a non-profit, parent-staff board model and whose ultimate goal is free, universal, accessible day care, may apply for funding.

If at the end of five years no group that thus satisfies the trustees has applied for these monies, the fund will be set up as an on-going scholarship in the name of Pat Schulz. The scholarship would be awarded each year to any student in Ontario in her/his final year of Early Childhood Education who has a strong interest in the concept of free, universal, accessible day care as a goal for Ontario.

Pat Schulz Memorial Fund



This fund is established to honour the memory of Patricia Vanderbelt Schulz. Pat once described herself as “a single mother, a feminist, a small time historian, a socialist, a day care activist, a co-op member — a lot of people.”

More useful, perhaps, is the picture of Pat as a truly unusual human being. Each day of her life she grew in her awareness and taught us all one thing: true health lies in our ability to bring together each part of our divided feelings — of personal commitment, of social consciousness and of political awareness — into an uncompromising recognition of the wholeness of living.

The lives of all of us who knew her and worked with her were changed, our visions challenged, our commitment strengthened and our sense of justice for women and their families sharpened for having lived, worked and dreamed beside this woman who was “a lot of people.”

The Pat Schulz Memorial Trust Fund will be used for the development of a Neighborhood Resource Centre to be named in her honour. It must represent the strength of a community serving the needs of children and their families with the comprehensive, ongoing and active thrust Pat saw as the nature of a genuine commitment to children and their world.
