

CHILD CARE FACILITIES

WHEREAS; Child Care has now become a central issue for trade unionists across Canada and the United States. Due to the lack of sufficient child care facilities, trade unionists, in many cases, are forced to quit their jobs, and

WHEREAS; If we are to make a breakthrough in negotiating adequate child care at the bargaining table, we must start within our own International Union, and

WHEREAS; Not only is this a problem for workers in plants and offices everywhere, but there is also a great need for a child care program for delegates attending UAW Conferences and Conventions,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That when Women's Conferences are held at the George Burt Family Education Centre and the Walter & May Reuther Family Education Centre, that arrangements be made to accommodate delegates requiring the use of child care facilities, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That consideration be given to providing child care facilities at UAW Constitutional Conventions and other conferences sponsored by the UAW.
