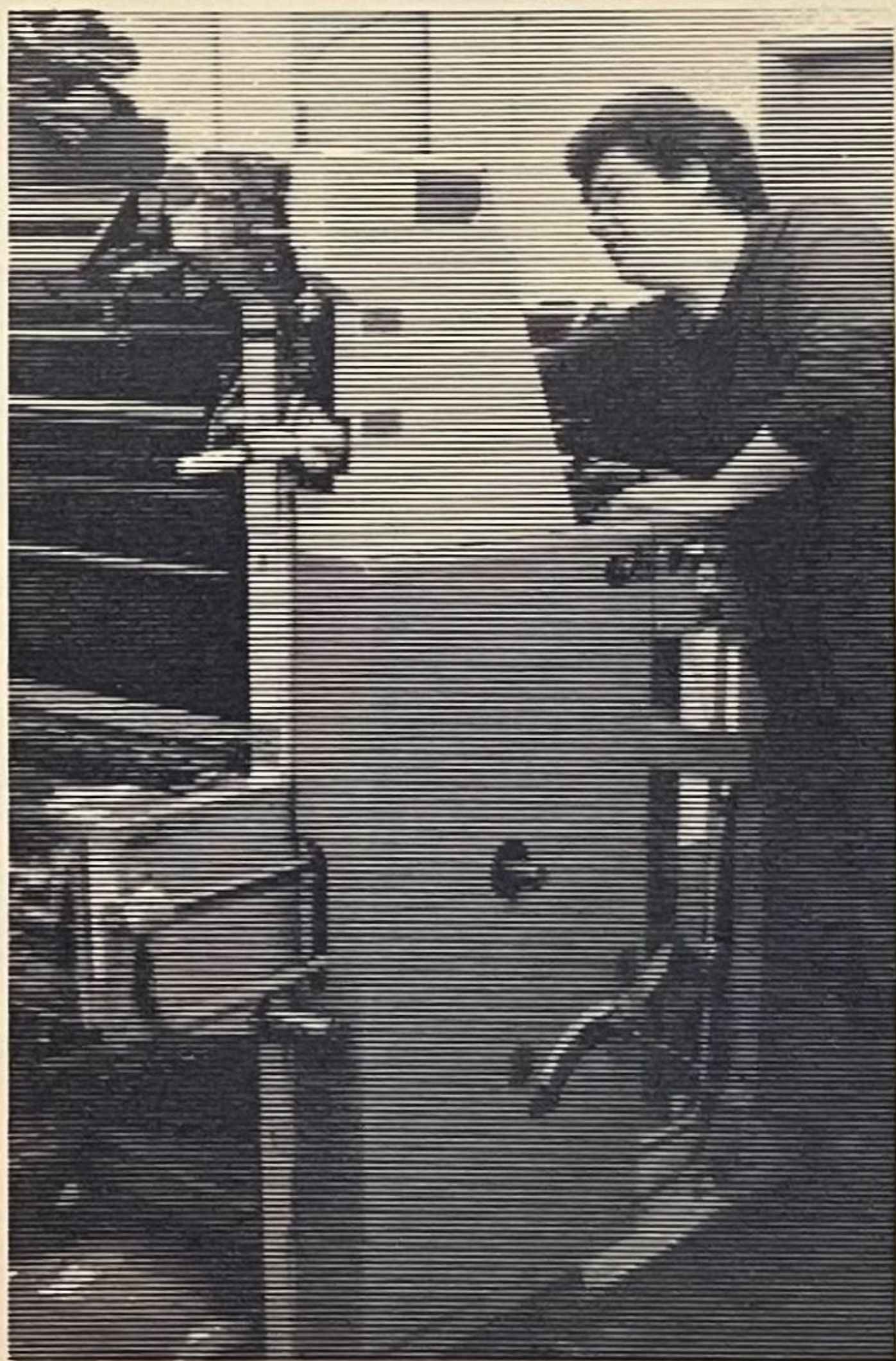

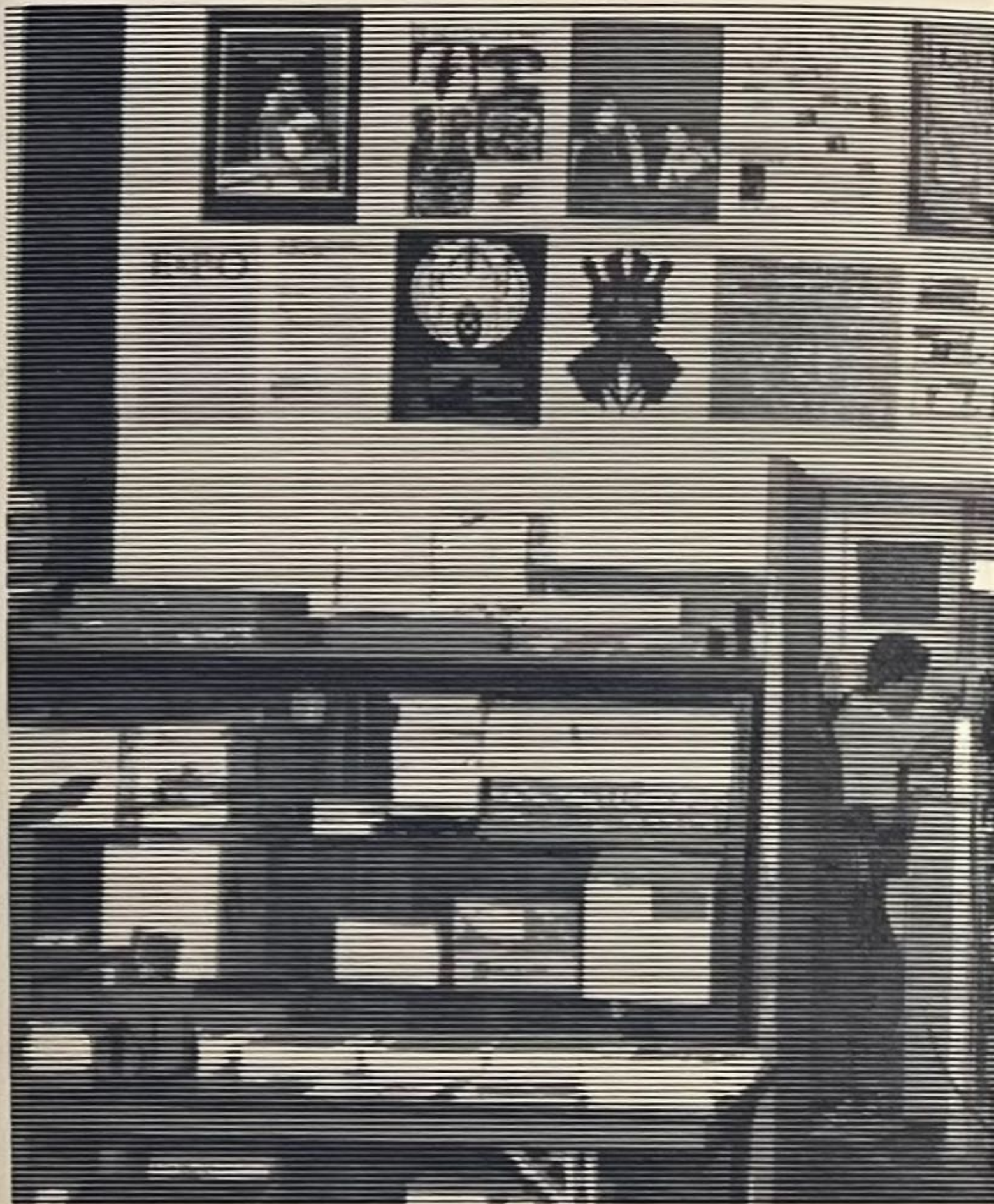
Press Gang Printers

Press Gang Printers plays an important role in providing access for women to non-traditional work. We do this without grants. Our print shop provides on-the-job training and permanent employment in the printing trades.

Our feminism is an integral part of how and why we work. Press Gang has always maintained an active presence in the Vancouver women's movement. Also, we will not print any material that is sexist, racist, or in any way discriminatory. We work closely with our sister collective, Press Gang Publishers, to make feminist books available.

Supporting unions is one way to support workers. Press Gang has always actively supported trade unions – with donations, letters, walking picket lines, and respecting “hot” declarations.

Supporting worker-controlled collectives is another way to support workers. Worker co-ops and collectives are actively promoting and developing democracy in the workplace.

Press Gang gives all workers equal say in decision-making. Our worker contract outlines our rights, responsibilities, and conditions of employment, including many model clauses.

Press Gang makes it a priority to help groups with little or no money get their materials into print. We do this by holding free workshops on layout and printing. We spend a lot of time advising our customers on different printing options, making sure they're getting the most for their money. We also offer the use of our layout and bindery equipment to groups who want to save money by doing their own.

Every month we offer a donation of printing services to a group in the community. We also give away notepads, stickers, and posters. The paid work you bring us generates the income for these services and donations.
