Nancy Drew & the Mystery of the Haunted Body

A Comedy about Incest, Freud, & Recovered Memory
Written & Directed by Marusya Bociurkiw
VHS & 3/4" video, 45 minutes, 1999, Canada

Flashlight forever in hand, Nancy Drew is the brash girl-detective in a girls' mystery book series produced from the 30's to the present day. Nancy Drew & the Mystery of the Haunted Body, a 45-minute dramatic short, rewrites the genre with an all-star Vancouver artworld cast, and featuring Toronto actor Kirsten Robek as Nancy Drew, and Vancouver's Carolyn Tweedle as The Mannish Academic. Performances by artists Eric Metcalfe, Hank Bull, and Lori Weidenhammer, and guest cameos by Oprah and Anais Nin make this a one-stop-shopping pop culture event!

Written in the feverish, multi-plot style of a Nancy Drew mystery, the story is set in the bland town of **Riverdale Heights**, where Nancy Drew works as researcher by day, detective by night. One day, Nancy gets called in by her boss, Doctor D. Nial (Eric Metcalfe) at The Psychology Institute (really a front for the False Memory Institute). A researcher has been killed, his papers stolen. Nancy must find them: they are Freud's original writings detailing the discovery of traumatic memory in his female clients. The plot thickens. The mysteries pile up. A Mannish Academic has her research ripped off; Nancy suspects a link with Freud when Mannish Academic shows Nancy the Incest Survivors' Hall of Fame, where **Roseanne**, **Nancy Sinatra** and the **Dionne Quintuplets** whisper clues. A racy sexual encounter, an appearance on a TV talkshow, and a final showdown with Dr D Nial follow.

Wacky special effects by video whiz **Shawn Chappelle**, and *noir*-ish soundscape by audio artist **Peter Courtemanche** create a topsy-turvy mood, like going back to the 50's with all your 90's irony intact. Marusya Bociurkiw is a Vancouver-based media artist, author, and academic. With this work she produces a haunted and haunting film that unpeels the complexities of memory, the unconscious and the nuclear family, with tongue-in-cheek panache.
