The Department of Social Science and the Office of the Master invite all interested members of the community to an evening of song.

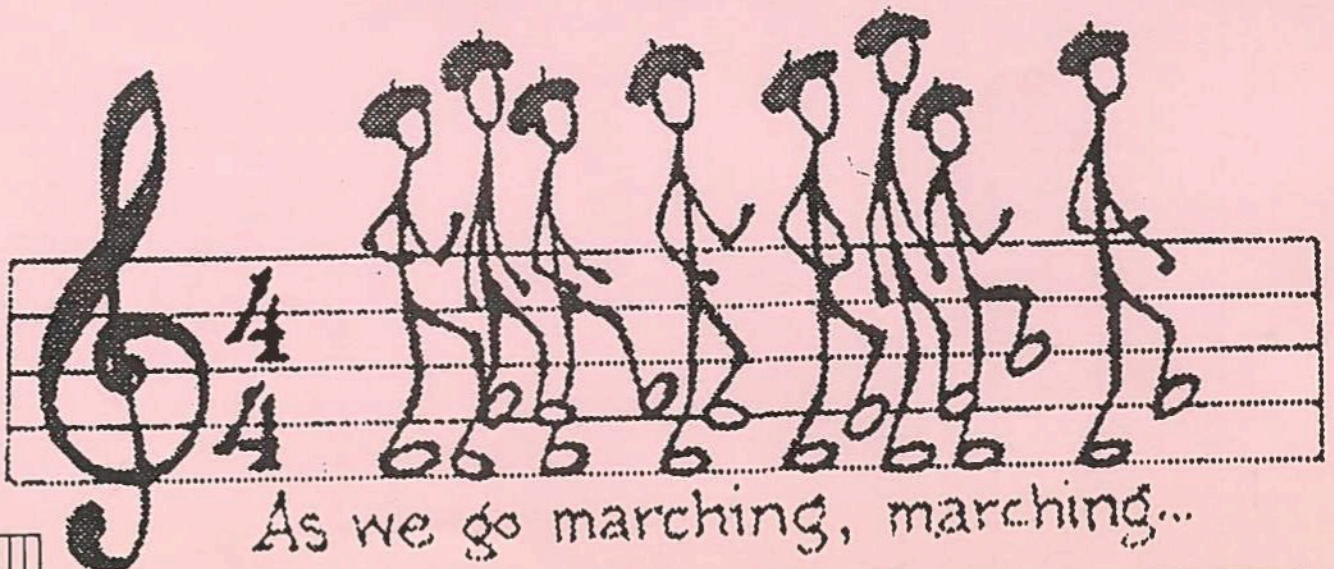
